Fri 1 Aug	Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: <i>"May those who love you be secure. May there be peace within your walls and security within your citadels"</i> (Psalm 122:6-7).
Sat 2 Aug Sabbath	<i>"The Lord had said to Abram, 'Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you. 'I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you'"</i> (Genesis 12:1-3). Pray that more and more people will choose to bless Israel.
Sun 3 Aug Tish'a B'Av	Tish'a B'Av (Commemorating the destruction of the two Temples). Today is a day of fasting and a National Day of Mourning for the Jewish people. It is a sad day, because on Tish'a B'av terrible events happened in the past. One of them is the destruction of both the first and the second Temple in Jerusalem. Pray that Jews worldwide may commemorate this day in peace.
Mon 4 Aug	Pray for consolation of the next of kin of those who were killed during the Iranian attacks and for the next of kin of the soldiers who were killed in Gaza.
Tue 5 Aug	The Israeli hospital Soroka in Beersheba was hit during the Iranian rocket attack on Israel. However, the miracle was that there was no one killed. This was due to the fact that the hospital was largely evacuated beforehand. Give thanks for this miracle.
Wed 6 Aug	In this day and age Israeli children witness war up close at a young age. Pray for their safety and wellbeing. Pray that they may be comforted when they are feeling sad. Pray that they may receive help whenever they need it.
Thu 7 Aug	It was recently revealed that a Hamas headquarters was hidden underneath one of the hospitals in Gaza. Pray that Hamas' perverse practice to use human shields stops.

Fri 8 Aug	In the New Testament, there are two recorded moments when Jesus wept. One of these was over the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple—the house of God. Pray for the restoration of the house of God in Jerusalem.
Sat 9 Aug Sabbath	<i>“He took him outside and said, ‘Look up at the sky and count the stars—if indeed you can count them.’ Then he said to him, ‘So shall your offspring be’”</i> (Genesis 15:5). Thank God for His great promise to Abraham and his offspring.
Sun 10 Aug	<i>“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth”</i> (Genesis 1:1). Thank God today that He is the Creator of the heavens and the earth. Thank Him that He is the Almighty, the beginning and the end. Thank Him for everything He gave, even before we could ask Him.
Mon 11 Aug	The Argentinian president Javier Milei has promised to move the Argentinian Embassy to Jerusalem in 2026. Milei stood up for Israel more often and made the ties between the two countries much stronger. Give thanks for everything Milei means to Israel.
Tue 12 Aug	The bond between the Jews and Persians is centuries old. Contrary to the Iranian Ayatollah regime, many Iranians long for peace with Israel. Pray for peace between the Iranian and Jewish people.
Wed 13 Aug	The United States of America is a key ally of Israel. It is one of the few countries that has supported Israel in both good and bad times. Pray for a blessing over the USA. Pray that the relations between the USA and Israel will remain strong in the years to come.
Thu 14 Aug	Within the United Nations Israel appears to be under a magnifying glass all the time. No other country received so many anti-resolutions as Israel. Pray for a turnaround in the anti-Israel policy of the UN. Pray that the hatred loses its power.
Fri 15 Aug	<i>“And many peoples and powerful nations will come to Jerusalem to seek the Lord Almighty and to entreat Him”</i> (Zechariah 8:22). Pray for fulfilment of this promise.
Sat 16 Aug Sabbath	<i>“Your house and your kingdom will endure forever before me; your throne will be established forever”</i> (2 Samuel 7:16). Thank God today for His promise.
Sun 17 Aug	The Jewish people are a living testimony to God’s everlasting faithfulness and promises. The people of the Bible still live among us and are a visible proof of God’s Word. This is not only a miracle, but also a source of great encouragement. Thank God that we can witness this today. Thank Him that He is forever faithful to His Word.
Mon 18 Aug	Psalms 122 invites us to pray for the peace of Jerusalem. The war between Israel and Hamas goes hand in hand with a strict anti-Israel sentiment in the media. That is why many Christians find it difficult to pray for Israel. Therefore, pray for wisdom and candor amongst Christians. Pray that they may again be open to pray for Israel. Pray for unity amongst Christians.
Tue 19 Aug	We may be thankful that we can learn more about who God is through Israel. Pray that we may learn more about God today, His people and His Word.
Wed 20 Aug	Fortunately there are many Christians who reach out to bless Israel. Pray for a blessing over these people.
Thu 21 Aug	Pray for the pastors and church leaders who have a heart for Israel, but find it difficult to speak about it in the congregation. Pray for courage and faith. Pray that God will give them the right words at the right time.
Fri 22 Aug	The Church has a painful history of antisemitism. This has caused a lot of damage to the relationship between Jews and Christians. Pray for humility in the Church. Pray that the relationship between Jews and Christians may heal more and more.
Sat 23 Aug Sabbath	<i>“The Lord will be king over the whole earth. On that day there will be one Lord, and His name the only name”</i> (Zechariah 14:9). Thank God for this hopeful prospect. Pray that this day may soon come.
Sun 24 Aug	<i>“The Lord reigns forever, your God, O Zion, for all generations. Praise the Lord”</i> (Psalm 146:10). Thank God today with these words.
Mon 25 Aug	If you look at antisemitism in the past, it is striking that the same slogans return all the time, only in a different guise. Pray that our eyes may be opened for places where antisemitism is lurking.
Tue 26 Aug	Research shows that almost half of all young Americans support Hamas over Israel. This is most likely partly influenced because of biased media coverage about the war in the different news channels. Pray that people may come to an understanding of what is really going on and which spiritual battle is raging behind the visible.

Wed 27 Aug	Ireland is the first European nation that will boycott products from Israeli settlements. Pray that other countries will not follow and that Ireland will repent.
Thu 28 Aug	Many Jewish students do not feel safe in their schools and universities. This sense of insecurity is reinforced by anti-Israel and anti-Jewish rallies at schools and campuses. Pray that school boards stand up for their own students and that the Jewish students will feel safe and supported in their own learning environment.
Fri 29 Aug	Hatred against Jews is centuries old, but that doesn't mean that we just have to accept it. Pray that the hatred against God's people will be broken. Pray that not a single charge against God's people will last.
Sat 30 Aug Sabbath	<i>"For the Lord is our judge, the Lord is our lawgiver, the Lord is our king; it is He who will save us"</i> (Isaiah 33:22). Thank God today with these words.
Sun 31 Aug	<i>"This is what the Lord says: 'Only if the heavens above can be measured and the foundations of the earth below be searched out will I reject all the descendants of Israel because of all they have done,' declares the Lord"</i> (Jeremiah 31:37). Thank God today for His everlasting faithfulness to His people.

September 2025

Mon 1 Sep	Jesus says that <i>"Every kingdom divided against itself will be ruined, and every city or household divided against itself will not stand"</i> (Matthew 12:25). Pray for unity amongst the Israeli population.
Tue 2 Sep	Judea and Samaria, known as the Biblical Heartland, are home to over half a million Jews today. Yet, many countries question Israel's right to this land. Pray for Judea and Samaria today, for the land and her inhabitants.
Wed 3 Sep	According to the Israeli Ministry of Aliyah and Integration 100 new immigrants from Europe arrived in Israel only one day after the start of the ceasefire with Iran. Thank God that He brings His people back to their Homeland.
Thu 4 Sep	<i>"On that day the Lord made a covenant with Abram and said, 'To your descendants I give this land, from the Wadi of Egypt to the great river, the Euphrates'"</i> (Genesis 15:18). Thank God for His promise. Pray for a blessing over the Land of Israel, that the people, the animals and nature may do well.
Fri 5 Sep	<i>"For a hundred pieces of silver, he bought from the sons of Hamor, the father of Shechem, the plot of ground where he pitched his tent. There he set up an altar and called it El Elohe Israel"</i> (Genesis 33:19-20). Shechem, the present-day Palestinian city of Nablus, is not a safe city for Jews to visit nowadays. It is even prohibited for Israeli citizens. Pray that this important place may again be safe for Jews to visit.
Sat 6 Sep Sabbath	<i>"Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, saying: 'To Him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!'"</i> (Revelation 5:13). Thank God today with these words.
Sun 7 Sep	<i>"Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, 'Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"</i> (Genesis 3:1). The doubts and lies of the opponent go back to the Garden of Eden. Pray that the truth of God's Word may shine brighter than the hatred and lies of the world.
Mon 8 Sep	In different countries, there are Iranians who at the risk of their own lives, publicly speak out for Israel. Pray for a blessing and protection over these people.
Tue 9 Sep	International law is an important weapon that is used by Israel's opponents and abuse of it poses an existential threat for the Jewish State. The organization <i>Thinc.</i> consists of a global network of experts in the field of international law who are committed to stop the abuse of international law against Israel. Pray for a blessing over this organization.
Wed 10 Sep	<i>"He will judge between many peoples and will settle disputes for strong nations far and wide. They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore"</i> (Micah 4:3). Pray that this time will soon come.
Thu 11 Sep	Give thanks that Israel has effectively been able to attack Iranian targets and weaken the regime. Because of this Iran has now restrained possibilities to attack Israel. Pray that Iran will not succeed in restarting the nuclear program.

Fri 12 Sep	Pray for the Israeli representatives working outside Israel. Pray for protection and courage. Pray that they may be a blessing for Israel.
Sat 13 Sep Sabbath	<i>"He confirmed it to Jacob as a decree, to Israel as an everlasting covenant: 'To you I will give the land of Canaan as the portion you will inherit'"</i> (Psalm 105:10-11). Thank God for this promise.
Sun 14 Sep	<i>"He is the Lord our God; His judgments are in all the earth. He remembers His covenant forever, the promise He made, for a thousand generations, the covenant He made with Abraham, the oath He swore to Isaac. He confirmed it to Jacob as a decree..."</i> (Psalm 105:7-9). Thank God for His everlasting covenant and promises.
Mon 15 Sep	<i>"He who watches over you will not slumber; indeed, He who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. The Lord watches over you— the Lord is your shade at your right hand"</i> (Psalm 121:4-5). Thank God for His protection. Pray that His people find confidence and courage through His Word.
Tue 16 Sep	Pray for safety and peace in the entire Middle East. Pray that Israel will no longer be threatened in its right to exist by surrounding countries.
Wed 17 Sep	Israel's air defence system is very important for the national security. With this system, rockets fired at Israel, can be stopped. Pray that Israel can continue to stop rockets from outside.
Thu 18 Sep	Pray for the Israeli soldiers who are stationed at the Israeli borders. Pray for safety and courage.
Fri 19 Sep	Secure borders are important for the safety of the entire country. Pray for secure borders of Israel, that Israel may be protected against evil from outside.
Sat 20 Sep	<i>"He will raise a banner for the nations and gather the exiles of Israel; He will assemble the scattered people of Judah from the four quarters of the earth"</i> (Isaiah 11:12). Thank God that He promised to bring His people back to His Land.
Sun 21 Sep	<i>"In the shelter of Your presence You hide them from all human intrigues; You keep them safe in Your dwelling from accusing tongues"</i> (Psalm 31:20). Pray that God's people may find refuge in His presence, hidden and protected from all human schemes and accusations.
Mon 22 Sep	Pray that the power and influence of Hezbollah and Hamas may be broken. Pray that the flows of money from Iran are running out and that these terror organizations have no means anymore to continue their terror.
Tue 23 Sep Rosh Hashana	Jewish New Year. <i>"Say to the Israelites: 'On the first day of the seventh month you are to have a day of sabbath rest, a sacred assembly commemorated with trumpet blasts'"</i> Leviticus 23:24. The past years were hard for the Jewish people with an intensive and long war with Hamas and worldwide increasing antisemitism. Pray for a blessing and peace in the new year.
Wed 24 Sep Rosh Hashana	Jewish New Year. Give thanks that God has set commemoration and holidays to reflect on God's provisions and faithfulness. Give thanks for God's faithfulness to His people Israel through the years.
Thu 25 Sep	Pray for Christians for Israel conferences and activities that will be organized worldwide. Pray that this may mean a lot for those who participate.
Fri 26 Sep	Give thanks for the work that Koen and Ira Carlier together with their team do in Ukraine for the Jewish community. They help, for example, Jewish Ukrainians who want to make aliyah. Pray that many people will receive help.
Sat 27 Sep	<i>"The Lord is the strength of His people, a fortress of salvation for His anointed one. Save your people and bless your inheritance; be their shepherd and carry them forever"</i> (Psalm 28:8). Pray that the Lord will be the strength and fortress for His people.
Sun 28 Sep	<i>"We also have the prophetic message as something completely reliable, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts"</i> (2 Peter 1:19). Pray that pastors will be guided by the prophetic Word.
Mon 29 Sep	Pray for the affiliates of Christians for Israel International worldwide. Pray that the good news, that Biblical prophecies are being fulfilled and God's people are coming home, will be heard all over the world.
Tue 30 Sep	It is written: <i>"'As surely as I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee will bow before me; every tongue will acknowledge God'"</i> (Romans 14:11). Thank God today for this promise.
