June 2026

Mon 1 June	More and more Jews from the United Kingdom want to emigrate (make Aliyah) to Israel due to rising antisemitism. Pray for opportunities for everyone who wants to make Aliyah and pray for protection of British Jews who are facing a great deal of antisemitism.
Tue 2 June	Every day new immigrants (Olim) arrive in Israel. After the initial accommodation by the government they have to integrate as soon as possible. Pray for appropriate housing, suitable employment and a speedy adaptation to language and culture.
Wed 3 June	About two hundred French-Jewish doctors who are interested in moving to Israel, gathered in Paris in May last for a large immigration fair for medical staff. This group is symbolic of many more French Jews who are considering emigrating to Israel. Four in five French Jews feel unsafe in France. Pray that French Jews who want to make Aliyah will be given the opportunity to do so at the moment of their choosing.
Thu 4 June	This year many Jews return from India to Israel as well. They belong to the tribe of Manasseh. Pray that these Jews can return to Israel as well and that they can settle in quickly in Israel as well.
Fri 5 June	Pray for a blessing on the work of Koen Carlier and his team in Ukraine. Pray that they can help many Jews with food parcels or other support. Also pray for Ukrainian Jews deciding to return to Israel.
Sat 6 June Sabbath	“The Lord builds up Jerusalem; He gathers the exiles of Israel.” Psalm 147:2. Give thanks that God is control.
Sun 7 June	“He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul.” Psalm 23:2-3. Pray for peace for the Jewish people.
Mon 8 June	Pray for protection and a blessing for the work of Christians for Israel in Ukraine. Pray for protection from the war when the assist Jewish people across the border and for a safe arrival at the airport in Kishenov, Moldova.

Tue 9 June	There is a specific drone (so-called FPV-drone) for which the IDF presently doesn't have a proper defense against. Hezbollah deployed these weapons against Israeli soldiers. One IDF-soldier was killed and several others were wounded. Pray that Israel will find ways to defend itself against these drones.
Wed 10 June	The Israel army (IDF) has created a safe zone in Lebanon behind which they have pushed back Hezbollah. Pray for protection of troops defending this zone and pray that this zone will provide more safety in northern Israel.
Thu 11 June	Recently a 19-year-old soldier died as a result of a missile attack by Hezbollah. Pray for comfort of the bereaved and also pray for the bereaved of other fallen soldiers.
Fri 12 June	There are signals that Hamas is trying to recover militarily and is trying to gain a stronger grip on the Gaza Strip again. Pray that Hamas will not succeed in this.
Sat 13 June Sabbath	"Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." 1 Thessalonians 5:18. Take time today to thank God for the things we take for granted but are actually a miracle in itself. Such as the sunrise every day and the air in our lungs.
Sun 14 June	"Let Israel rejoice in their Maker; let the people of Zion be glad in their King." Psalm 149:2. Pray for joy among the people of Israel regarding their Maker.
Mon 15 June	One of the key points in the peace plan of US President Donald Trump for Gaza was disarming Hamas. In practice this is very difficult. Pray that progress can be achieved in this and that Hamas is forced to lay down its arms.
Tue 16 June	Israel recently destroyed eight tunnels in northern Gaza and eliminated several terrorists. Give thanks for this and pray that all Hamas tunnels will ultimately be rendered harmless.
Wed 17 June	Because of the war many Israeli children are traumatized and struggle with adaptation and concentration problems. Pray for good and affordable help for these children.
Thu 18 June	Pray for the protection of IDF soldiers against all sorts of attacks.
Fri 19 June	The army chief of staff of the Israeli army has recently delivered a speech in which he calls for adherence to high moral standards. This is due to an incident (amongst others) of an incident during which a statue of Jesus was pulled down by an Israeli soldier. Pray that the call to action may have an effect and that soldiers will choose correctly in the stressful situations they endure.
Sat 20 June Sabbath	"I ask then: Did God reject His people? By no means! I am an Israelite myself, a descendant of Abraham, from the tribe of Benjamin." Romans 11:1. Give thanks that God didn't reject His people. Thank God that He is faithful.
Sun 21 June	"The Sovereign Lord declares—He who gathers the exiles of Israel: "I will gather still others to them besides those already gathered."" Isaiah 56:8. Pray that more and more Jews may return to their Homeland.
Mon 22 June	Christians for Israel in Nepal wants to set up a radio station. Pray for the plans that are being developed and that many people will be reached in this way.
Tue 23 June	Last year the Israeli population grew by 146,000 people. There were 21,000 immigrants and 177,000 children were born. Give thanks for this population growth despite the war and the threats.
Wed 24 June	Pray for the exposure of spies for Iran inside Israel.
Thu 25 June	Pray for a blessing on the work of Shin Bet, the Israel Security Agency and the Mossad, Israel's Institute for Intelligence and Special Operations. Pray for protection of the secret agents who work for these organizations and pray that they will succeed in preventing attacks worldwide and in Israel.
Fri 26 June	The Israeli Government has approved a development program for the Golan Heights worth billions of euros. With this program Israel wants to improve the stability in this important border region and also provide extra security for the whole of Israel. Pray for a blessing on this program.
Sat 27 June Sabbath	"You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain." Psalm 139:5-6. Give thanks today that God cares for Israel every day, and for us as well.
Sun 28 June	Pray for the peace of Jerusalem and her inhabitants (Psalm 122).
Mon 29 June	Education in Israel is continually disrupted by the war. Students are sometimes home for weeks on end, and despite online classes, have fallen behind. Pray for a good start after the summer holidays.
Tue 30 June	Former hostage Eliya Cohen has been left with a shattered foot during imprisonment. He had an operation in mid-April and hopes to be able to stand on his wedding in July. Pray for a successful recovery of his foot and for a blessed wedding.

July 2026

Wed 1 July	Pray for a normalization of air traffic to and from Israel, so that families can visit each other again during holidays and special occasions.
Thu 2 July Fast 17 Tamuz	The Seventeenth of Tammuz is a Jewish fast day commemorating the breach of the walls of Jerusalem before the destruction of the Second Temple. During each summer period the Israeli Government launches a summer program for school-age children. Pray that many children will benefit from this program.
Fri 3 July	Am Israel Echad is the largest Israeli educational institute to help young people discover their Jewish identity. Every year some 45,000 children participate in their programs, like visiting a synagogue, a visit to the Kotel and numerous other social activities. Pray that the Jewish identity will strengthen them and they will be proud of their heritage.
Sat 4 July Sabbath	“For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished.” Matthew 5:18. Thank God that His Word is eternal and that we got to know His Word through Jesus.
Sun 5 July	“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.” Proverbs 9:10. Pray for wisdom in the Church and in her attitude relating to Israel.
Mon 6 July	In the Philippines a conference is planned to take place from July 7-9. During the conference regional speakers will be equipped to spread the Biblical message about Israel. Pray for a blessed time of education, deeper understanding and mutual encouragement.
Tue 7 July	“Theirs are the patriarchs, and from them is traced the human ancestry of the Messiah, who is God over all, forever praised! Amen.” Romans 9:5. Pray that Christians may see the profound connection with the people of Israel.
Wed 8 July	Pray that God will help us to better understand His profound relationship with His people Israel.
Thu 9 July	Pray that we may better understand and fully get to know Jesus, as the Messiah from Israel. Pray that we may get to know Jesus like the Father knows Him.
Fri 10 July	Pray for protection of Jewish institutions outside Israel (like schools and synagogues) against attacks. Pray that the security is well organized and that Israel’s enemies will not succeed to damage the buildings.
Sat 11 July Sabbath	“Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; His greatness no one can fathom.” Psalm 145:3. Thank God that He far greater and wiser than we can imagine.
Sun 12 July	Pray that the Lebanese Government will take action against Hezbollah, that they will phase out their collaboration.
Mon 13 July	In Hungary new political leaders have been chosen who are not as pro-Israel as the former PM Orbán. Pray that the new leaders will ultimately adopt a positive attitude towards Israel.
Tue 14 July	Shortly after the start of the war with Iran it became clear that Turkey – which normally regards Iran as an enemy – did not support the prospect of change in Iran. This is based amongst others on a possible Kurdish uprising that could spread to Turkey. Turkey is therefore hostile towards Israel during the war. Pray that Turkey will not pose a danger to Israel and will not hinder the Israeli defense against its enemies.
Wed 15 July	Israelis worldwide received text messages from an Iranian group of hackers in which they were threatened. Pray for protection against this kind of attacks and that Israelis are not discouraged because of this.
Thu 16 July	In the EU more and more countries want to suspend the association treaty between the EU and Israel. Amongst others this treaty regulates trade between the EU and Israel. Pray that this suspension will not take place.
Fri 17 July	The current Chancellor of Germany, Friedrich Mertz, has said that “the attacks on Israel must stop”. This is a clear statement and differs from previous statements from Mertz in which he calls on Israel for military restraint in the Middle East. Pray that other countries will also speak out against the attacks against Israel and thus act as an Israeli ally.
Sat 18 July Sabbath	“Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures through all generations.” Psalm 145:13a. Kingdoms in this world fall and people return to ashes, but God will always remain. Give thanks that God is the Eternal One.
Sun 19 July	Jusoor News is an Arab news medium that was founded two years ago and employs more than 70 local reporters in Gaza, where they work undercover. Jusoor News recently brought to light that Hamas members commit acts of sexual violence against Gazan women and children. Pray that

	<p>Hamas will stop to exist and pray that Jusoor News can continue to expose this kind of abuse and thereby change the public opinion on Hamas.</p>
Mon 20 July	<p>“I will rejoice in doing them good and will assuredly plant them in this land with all My heart and soul.” (Jeremiah 32:41) Thank God that, even long before we were here, He promised that He would plant His people Israel in His land. Thank God that this is all in His hands.</p>
Tue 21 July	<p>A candidate nominated for a senior role in the UN Human Rights Council has openly voiced support for Hamas. It stands to reason that Israel is very uncomfortable with this nomination. Pray that the UN, that unjustly condemned Israel so many times already, stops slandering Israel and pray that this candidate is forced to withdraw.</p>
Wed 22 July	<p>Today you hear increasingly hear in the media, and even from other Christians, that Israelis are the new Nazis. Pray for exposure of this lie that totally reverses reality.</p>
Thu 23 July Tish'a B'Av (Annual Fast)	<p>“If I forget you, Jerusalem, may my right hand forget its skill. May my tongue cling to the roof of my mouth if I do not remember you...” Psalm 137:5-6a. On this fast day the Jewish people commemorate a number of disasters that happened to them. Like the destruction of both the First Temple and Second Temple in Jerusalem and the start of the deportations of the Holocaust. Pray that besides a day of mourning this may also be a day of comfort.</p>
Fri 24 July	<p>In recent months, an Iranian terrorist organization has been active several times to attack Jews worldwide. Amongst others by causing explosions at Jewish institutions. Pray for protection of Jews against threats from this network and pray that this network is dismantled.</p>
Sat 25 July Sabbath	<p>“He has revealed His word to Jacob, His laws and decrees to Israel.” Psalm 147:19. Give thanks that God choose Israel as His people and that He blesses the entire earth through Israel.</p>
Sun 26 July	<p>Many Holocaust survivors feel that the wars continued during their life and never stopped. For them denying the Holocaust is extremely painful. Pray for this group of elderly people who have been through so much already.</p>
Mon 27 July	<p>Recently, two Jewish men were attacked with a knife in London. They were badly injured. Pray that these men will recover and pray for protection of Jews against these kinds of attacks. In this case there was someone who had tried to stop the attacker. Pray that people will always stand up to help Jewish people.</p>
Tue 28 July	<p>Pray for pastors and theologians as they study God's Word. Pray for an understanding of God's plan with Israel and pray for wisdom when they share God's Word with others.</p>
Wed 29 July	<p>‘Keep me from deceitful ways; be gracious to me and teach me Your law’ (Psalm 119:29). Pray for the breaking of lies and misconceptions about Israel that persist among Christians.</p>
Thu 30 July	<p>‘I will speak of your statutes before kings and will not be put to shame’ (Psalm 119:46). Standing up for Israel can be very challenging because of possible hostile counterreactions. Pray for courage for Christians to stand up for Israel if given the opportunity to do so.</p>
Fri 31 July	<p>Let us remain vigilant and seek to understand the times we are living in by setting the right priorities: following the Lord Jesus and living in expectation of His return. Read Matthew 24:32–44.</p>
